





- IAL: for international students (outside UK), modular exams
- Phy/chem/bio
  - 6 modules for each subject
  - Units 1,2,4,5: subject knowledge papers
  - Units 3, 6: alternative to practical papers (no need to conduct the actual experiments)
- Math
  - 6 modules
  - P1, P2, P3, P4: core papers
  - M1, M2, S1, S2, D1: select 2
  - S5 in 22/23: P1, P2, P3, P4, M1, S1
- Jan, June, Oct
- Cash-in: choose the one with better result out of 2 most recent attempts

#### Why IAL?

- 1. Adapts better to the strengths of students
- 2. Can opt out of weaker subjects (e.g. Chinese)
- 3. IAL papers can be retaken (Jan, May, Oct; most recent 2 attempts)
- 4. Easier to get top grades
- 5. Submit applications to individual local universities themselves

(you may get multiple offers; you got one result from JUPAS: either accept or decline)

- 6. Less overwhelming
- 7. International qualification
- 8. Graduates are globally minded
- 9. Breadth and depth of learning
- 10. A lot less expensive than studying UK A Level abroad)

#### For Whom is IAL Suitable?

- for pupils with a very clear focus on a particular subject area
- who want to play to existing strengths
- (i.e. strong in math and science, proficient in English)

#### IAL Admission Requirement

- Students attaining at least 50% of marks in English Language, Mathematics and all science subjects in S.3
- priority will be given to students who excel in math and science subjects.
- Students demonstrating maturity in making an informed choice in an interview

# International Curriculum: School Fee and 'cross-subsidization'

- By offering IAL curriculum, our College may require to recruit teacher(s) and purchase additional materials (including reference books), the School Fee in 2023-2024 is about \$46,730 which is slightly higher than those studying DSE curriculum.
- Extra expenses like manpower for IAL curriculum can be covered by the additional school fee and basic subsidy from EDB. Hence, no problem of 'cross-subsidization'.
